# THE PROJECT

# "Towards a Green Europe approach: Green ICT solutions for Youth Entrepreneurship enhancement" StayGreen

The main activity of the project is the training of young people (aged 18-30) in the field of green entrepreneurship, namely the implementation of Green ICT in enterprises from Germany, Greece, Turkey and Lithuania using non-formal education methods. The project's curriculum is structured in such a way that includes experiential non-formal education activities and gradually and graded to allow young participants to deepen the subject of mobility (application of Green ICT to youth entrepreneurship). In this way, they are expected to understand and embrace the implementation of green practices in entrepreneurship as well as to strengthen their training on Green ICT in general. The individual objectives are achieved through appropriate activities that allow the trainee to develop his / her critical ability, express himself / herself, but also deepen the work object to conquer it. During our project we will mainly rely on informal and non-formal education. We want to introduce interactive games, icebreakers, energizers, non-formal activities, outside sessions. Our goal is also to make our workshops flexible and open for participant's ideas, like creating choreographies. All these things in small groups to make work more efficient. We want atmosphere of work to be relaxed and friendly to make better integration of the group and as a result to cause better communication and better opportunity to learn from each other, share ideas, consult, make decisions and participate actively. All the participants will be actively involved during the whole duration of the project. The youth exchange activities are based on the non-formal learning methods. The topics that will be touched upon are divided into daily thematic. The whole project will be done through the methods of non-formal education. The activities will include brainstorming, plenary discussions, simulations, role plays, team building, energizers, ice breakers etc.

Meeting the cultures from different regions of Europe, will give an opportunity to get to know and to explore cultural diversity, as well. Discussions about differences/common grounds and interpersonal interaction among young people from various countries will raise understanding and acceptance of these differences. We will promote tolerance and understanding of diversity in all our activities by focusing exercises and discussions on specific topics.

### **PARTICIPANTS PROFILE**

Participants of the **StayGreen** project have the following profile:

- ✓ 25 participants (5 per partner), aged 18-30 years old,
- ✓ 5 youth leaders (1 per partner), no age limit,
- ✓ communicative level of English,
- ✓ motivated to take active part in all workshops during the activity,
- ✓ willing to share their knowledge, skills and experience with the other participants and act as multipliers in their communities

The selection criteria of participants are:

✓ In equally good evaluated applications, then the previous experience in such kind of projects will be taken into account – the participants who have <u>never</u> <u>participated to an Erasmus+ project</u> will have <u>priority</u> to the ones that have already been to be introduced to the European values and develop a sense of European citizenship and identity and also have the opportunity to raise their awareness of other countries and cultures.

#### PREPARATION OF PARTICIPANTS

The mobility will be in **English** and therefore participants should be able to communicate in English.

**Intercultural Night**: Participants are requested to present their home country and its culture to the group (no use of presentations, etc.) by telling a short story about it, bringing some traditional food, perform a dance, or some other tradition.

Youthpass Certificates: All participants will receive a Youthpass certificate at the end of the mobility.

# Training Venue: Kirchpl. 1, 82041, Oberhaching, Germany

The activity will take place in Oberhaching, near Munich, which is one of the largest cities of Germany, a unique city of different cultures and civilizations; it will offer you a wonderful experience. Training will take place in the Seminar Room of the **Gefsis Restaurant facilities complex**. There is a large, fully equipped seminar room along with all necessary facilities to host a Youth Exchange.











Accommodation: Servus Apartments by Homaris, St.-Martin-Straße 38, 81541 München, Germany (https://www.homaris.org/)

A booking has been done in shared dorms in **Servus Apartments by Homaris**, with individual bathrooms, respecting gender balance. Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner are also provided by the project. As the hotel is in an area far from the venue (non-walking distance), daily tickets for public transportation will be provided by the host.

Participants can arrive two days before or/and depart two days after the end of the project, however they must cover accommodation and meals by their own budget.

#### THE EUROPEAN HEALTH INSURANCE CARD

#### **TRAVEL**

In line with the Erasmus+ Programme, travel costs will be refunded according to the distances calculated using the European Commission distance calculator. The participants themselves should cover any extra costs overcoming the budget limits. To ensure the best connection and management of participants, flight tickets should be bought by the participants/sending organization.

Travel tickets should be economy class and before buying tickets inform uDevelop (send an email to contact@udevelop.de for approval) of your travel itinerary, when you will arrive and when you will departure from training. 1st class or other upper class flight tickets, taxi costs (in country of origin) and travel agencies fees are not eligible and will not be refunded.

#### **REIMBURSEMENT OF TRAVEL TICKETS**

Reimbursement will be made upon <u>full attendance</u> of the activity, <u>submission of Participants' Report (this is MANDATORY)</u> via the Beneficiary Module and upon <u>providing original evidence</u> of participants' travel:

- 1. Travel Itinerary
- 2. All original payment receipts of ticket purchasing and Visa where required
- 3. All original Bus/Train tickets to/from the airport (use of TAXI or private car for use in the country of origin will NOT be covered).
- 4. Boarding passes (in case of electronic boarding passes, you should keep a screen shot and email them to uDevelop before flying)
- 5. Copy of ID/Passport
- 6. Submission of Participants' Report

People who are coming late or leaving early at the Activity will not have their travel costs refunded.

Note that if you buy your tickets in a currency different to EURO, calculation of travel reimbursement will be calculated according to the exchange rates given on the official European Commission website for the month of the ticket purchase.

All travel reimbursements will be done to the <u>Sending Partner Organizations' Bank Accounts</u> and not to each participant individually.
