It's been already 27 years ago when the revolution spread all over Europe and the hope returned to the people for a better future. Citizens were enthusiastic to make a change they had been fighting for democracy for ages and now we are not able use our rights. What happened after all?

There are many projects running lately in Europe using non-formal education, trying to tackle the problem. Most of them stucked in showing and talking about the facts instead of help to understand the problems or show the best practices and opportunities to be an active citizen.

The concept of the project revolves around the analogies between the world active citizenship and theater methods to recognize, analyze and develop key competences using non-formal education and self-directed learning.

Through this exchange participants will be learning how to:

- be open to other cultures and share their own ideas and point of view
- develop their self-confidence, communication skills and self-expression
- work in a group as a team member
- be a more active citizen themselves

During the project we will ask the participants to show their ideas as feelings through acting and write them down as our aim to edit a newspaper till the end of the program about the experience they collect and the consequence they had.

We encourage the teams to take the newspaper home and as a follow-up process translate it to their languages and spread it in their own country.



Date and Venue

The exchange will be held between 11th -17th of April, 2018, that includes traveling days.

The accommodation is in “ÖKO-Land Tábor” (ECO-Land Camp) which is located in Bánk, 60 km far from Budapest. The place is equipped with their own restaurant, training room(s) and includes wooden houses with rooms for 3-4 people and with common bathrooms for 2 rooms.
