Content

Equal Opportunities in Youth Work Project is a training course project to be carried out in the type of mobility of youth workers of the Erasmus+ programme. The training course to be organized within the scope of the project will be organized in Muğla between 9 - 17 April 2022, and 30 active youth workers from 10 different countries will be included in the project. 3 trainers will take part in the project and 3 facilitators will support the training organization.

The target groups of the project will be carried out by youth workers from Turkey, Albania, Czech Republic, Italy, Lithuania, Poland, Romania, Spain and Ukraine are youth workers, individuals with physical and mental disabilities and young people with fewer opportunities. Participants who will receive training within the scope of the project and disseminate the project outputs will be selected from among the youth workers who actively work in our partner organizations. Participants who have experience in the field, have worked with disabled individuals or have disabled individuals in their target groups will be included in our project.



Objectives



- to offer disabled and disadvantaged individuals equal opportunities within youth work,
- to ensure that disabled and disadvantaged young people are aware of and benefit from youth opportunities,
- to create strategies to increase the adaptation of disabled people to social life,
- to integrate good practices in the field of youth with practices to be carried out with disabled people,
- to include individuals with fewer opportunities in youth work to the maximum extent,
- to provide youth workers with the knowledge and skills they will need when working with disabled individuals,
- to prepare projects for the needs of the disabled and to include disabled people at all stages of the projects
- to produce innovative and inclusive methods for the disabled,
- to diversify and use non-formal education methods with disabled young people,
- to cooperate with organizations that work with disabled and disadvantaged individuals,
- to research good practices and to ensure the development and dissemination of these practices,
- to contribute more people with disabilities to benefit from European opportunities by increasing the visibility and accessibility of the Erasmus + program.

- Each team will present the current situation about fewer opportunities in their own country. We are looking for the answers to the questions below in the presentations.

(What is the main target group in your country that has fewer opportunities (refugees, youth in rural areas, Roma youth, disabled youth, etc?), What is the main reason for this situation?, What are the best practices for social inclusion of these youngsters done by the state or civic sector?)

- We are planning to organize a Cultural Night during the project. You can bring some snacks, foods, drinks, gifts ext for sharing and presenting your country to all participants.
- According to the arrivals and departures of the participants, the schedule can be updated.
- All participants have to join all sessions actively.
- Participants should follow the rules about Covid-19 measurements.
- We suggest you bring sports clothes for the activities.
- You can come to Turkey max. 3 days earlier or/and you can leave the country max. 3 days later. If you do this, your stay should be on the route. The participants should arrange their logistics on their own in the extra days.

Details

Non-formal and informal learning methods will be used throughout the project. The working language will be English and there will be sessions focused on experiential learning. Youth workers, who will take training within the scope of the project, will improve their professional, personal and social skills, expand youth work and enable young people who have not benefited from youth and European opportunities before.

Participants, who will take part in the project will increase their knowledge and experience as youth workers on the project themes. Participants, who will work in an international environment for disabled and disadvantaged young people to benefit from youth opportunities, will contribute to their professional, personal and social development in this process.

The organizations that will take part in the project will develop their partner network by collaborating with local youth and disabled organizations. Our partners, who will expand the network of stakeholders and supporters, will increase their work for the benefit of society and their institutional capacities.

4 projects and 4 methods will be produced for disabled and disadvantaged young people within the scope of the project. The projects and methods produced will be shared with young people and youth organizations in our target groups throughout the dissemination process. It is planned to reach the maximum number of disabled and disadvantaged young people with the road map to be prepared at the end of the project.

With the project, it is targeted to provide disabled and disadvantaged individuals with equal opportunities in youth work and to make the most of these young people benefit from youth and European opportunities. In line with this goal, it is planned to ensure equality of opportunity in local youth work carried out in 10 countries in the short term and to contribute youth and disability policies in the long term.

Participant Profiles

- Each team will be represented 3 participants in the training course.
- Participants should have minimum 1 year youth work experience as a youth worker.
- We take care of gender equality. That's why at least 1 male and 1 female participant should be included in the teams.
- Each team has to choose minimum 1 disadvantaged participant as geographical, economic, cultural differences or physical disability.
- There is no age limit but the participants should be over 18 years old.
- Participants should have basic knowledge about project themes.
- Participants are expected to be prone to non-formal education methods.
- Participants have to join all sessions all training course long.
- Working language will be English. Participants should communicate with the others actively.
- Participants have to disseminate the project results after the training course. They have to reach minimum 10 young people and present/implement outputs of the project.

DON'T BUY ANY TICKET BEFORE OUR CONFIRMATION

Participants have to keep all travel documents (E-tickets, Invoices, Boarding Passes ext.) and give them to the project team during the training course.

All tickets should be round-trip tickets. Reimbursements will be done in cash during the project in Turkey.

We suggest you buy flexible or refundable tickets. If any cancellation happens, participants are responsible for their own ticket arrangements.

Health Registration (Mandatory for all)
