

### YOUTH EXCHANGE

**PLACE AND DATE:** (19-30 October 2019) to Istanbul, Turkey

**PARTICIPANTS:** 60 people (8 youth + 2 group leader from each countries)

**COUNTRY:** Partner countries will be from **Iceland, Denmark, Lithuania, Turkey, UK, Hungary.**

**LANGUAGE:** The working language will be English.

# SUMMARY

The projects intend to instruct the participants all about the dynamic citizenship, law and to assume a dynamic part in political life in their own nations and Europe. The participants will become acquainted with challenges of the arrangements in their countries, make a nation in their mind that how they might want to live in and make a in order to the end goal to advise the group how much the governmental elections are imperative for the following future. With a wide range of workshops participants will meet up and debate about the main topics identified with the dynamic citizenship learning of the general public and attempt to locate the best arrangements how to expand the quantity of individuals that will effectively be in the political life in their own particular group. The most imperative subjects are; Benefits of human rights and citizenship in various countries, how parliaments part in a governments, gatherings to become more acquainted with about administrative experts in various countries, diverse writes and types of governance, perfect state/nation of dreams, voting is the fundamental method to go to the political life in the country, making a parliament consisting of youth and meeting with the local politicians talking about the principle issues, how to encourage youngsters to draw in them to be dynamic in political life, dynamic EU citizenship for a superior Europe and better future.

Numerous non-formal education strategies will be utilized, for example, introductions, conceptualizing, role-play so as to include all participants effectively in Project.

The Project will also contain numerous exercises to enhance communication and leadership skills and to don't hesitate to Express their conclusions and advance tolerance. During the Project participant will make many workshops and arrange intentional activities so as to impart their insights with each other and talk about with the local authorities why it is valuable for society to vote in elections. Participants will impart all their insight and experiences to their local environment and help the youngsters to be dynamic in political life in their community. Brochures and magazine will be made during the Project that contains many vital information about the decisions and voting. All those handouts and information will be distributed by web-based social networking or local media to have a long-term impact.

## ACTIVITIES AND METHODS

The working methods: energizers, name games, team-building games, researches, seminars, presentations, videops, public speaking, brainstormings, role-playing games, world cafe, group works, round tables, discussions, debates, voting, visits to local authorities, meetings with local youth, quizzes, city tours, interviews, collection and analysis of information materials gathered for creating brochures, photos and videos, self- and group reflections. All methods require the active participation of young people.

We distributed tasks and responsibilities for project management between promoters: all promoters will be prepared to participate actively in all activities. But for enhancing interactivity, developing leadership skills and deep diving in topics of project, the team leaders of each group will be responsible for conducting several activities.

### Who can participate in the youth exchange?



The youths that will be a part of the youth exchange Civil Initiative will have an age project in the between of 16 and 30 years of age, as it is determined in the manual of Erasmus+. We have talked about with our partners and we anticipate no issues identified with the age without bounds participants, as each partner is managing this age range once a day, in their home groups and they approach a wide range of youths. For the group leaders there is in fact no restriction, but we might want to choose capable individuals from the partner associations that are also in this age range, in order to have an equable group. Obviously, if it's the situation, having group leaders more established than 30 won't be an issue and age will not constitute a discriminatory criterion.

## TRAVEL COSTS

According to new Erasmus Plus rules, the reimbursement of travel costs will be calculated used a specific program called Distance Calculator:

**AFTER SENDING** their tickets and boarding cards, participants will receive the reimbursement of their travel costs. Travel (flights, other means of transport) expenses are compensated (up to 100%), based on the actual expenses incurred and the distance from your location of residence to the location of the project (**Diyarbakir**). These distances must be calculated using the distance calculator supported by the European Commission. We don't send money to each participants. We send only money to sender organization and sender organization will pay to participants. It may be that money from European Commission will be late; in that case, as mentioned, you will get your reimbursement after the course by bank transfer (be ready for that).

Accommodation, living and other project-related expenses: 100% funded by the EU. This includes everything except for travel costs.

*Please note any extra days you wish to stay will be your own responsibility and your food etc.*

**Visa costs** will be covered by participants.

## THE VENUE



**Istanbul** (Turkish: *İstanbul*), once known as **Constantinople** and **Byzantium** before that, is the most populous city in Turkey, and the country's economic, cultural, and historical center. Istanbul is a transcontinental city in Eurasia, straddling the Bosphorus strait between the Sea of Marmara and the Black Sea. Its commercial and historical center lies on the European side and about a third of its population lives on the Asian side. The city is the administrative center of



the Istanbul Metropolitan Municipality (coterminous with Istanbul Province), both hosting a population of around 14 million residents. Istanbul is one of the world's most populous cities and ranks as world's 5th-largest city proper and the largest European city.

**Note:** Organisers will not provide accommodation for any additional stay in Istanbul. If participants plan to arrive a few days earlier or depart a few days later, they are kindly requested to inform us and we will be glad to offer assistance with booking a hotel. 2 days before project or 2 days after project only allowed. This is no holiday, so please respect the Erasmus+ projects rules.
