# **Context and Objectives**

The project Youth Exchange Green Social Entrepreneurship will be on two levels:

1. Participants

- acquired new competencies, new contacts from abroad, new knowledge, learning about intercultural differences, learning about the environment, countries, EU

- acquaintance with the field of green social entrepreneurship in Slovenia and EU
- Presentation of the possibilities of a supportive environment in the EU

- strengthening self-confidence, public speaking, spreading social and entrepreneurial ideas and working in a group and others.

- 2. Organizations
- strengthening the knowledge of their members and thus capacity building
- strengthening EU integration of youth organizations
- enhancing EU values through youth work and others.

The project is important for youth work as it offers innovative methods to involve young people in the voluntary activities of organisations, as well as an opportunity to gain competences to enter the labour market in a fast growing industry. Through non-formal education on video games and e-sports, we are breaking down the prejudices that young electronic game enthusiasts experience when trying to professionalise these activities. The project aims to show that innovative approaches and cutting-edge technological solutions can be used to integrate young people into society and the labour market. The youth exchange project involves 27 participants from 5 different countries, including at least 10 participants with fewer opportunities. The target group of participants are young people with cultural,

social and economic barriers who are video game and e-sports enthusiasts. The project includes activities at local level and activities to be carried out during the six days of the youth exchange.
