Number of Participants: 8 participants + 1 group leader

Age: 18-30 (but we would recommend to have 3-4 participants 18-25 and 3-4 between 25-30)

#### **Expenses:**

There is no any participation fee or any other expenses. You just need to bring pocket-money for ice-cream, gifts...

#### **Arrival / Departure:**

The arrival day is on the 14<sup>th</sup> of October and the departure day is on the 22<sup>nd</sup> of October. We will create a facebook group for all participants and we will support participants to reach the project venue easily.

**Travel Expenses:** We have budget according to Erasmus + distance calculator rules.

## What We Expect From Partners:

Each partner country will be responsible from preparation of their teams and also prepare a workshop to be led during the project. Partner organizations need to plan them with their team and share their plan -which has to be based on non-formal methods- with organizers before coming to Norway.

Turkey and Italy will lead 2 different workshops with 'Recycle' subject, Lithuania and Germany will lead 2 different workshops with 'Reuse' subject, Bulgaria and Portugal will lead 2 different workshops with 'Reduce' subject.

## Foods:

We arranged a very nice plan to focus on project subject and get to know each other better.

However, we will have some logistical responsibilities for all participants: Everything will be self organized and we will be responsible from our daily food. Lunches and dinners will be cooked by international teams and every day, new people will take responsibilities.

## What to bring:

- Towels and bath accessories (shampoo, tooth paste etc.)
- Traditional food, drinks etc for the intercultural evening
- Your passport
- All your travel tickets!!! (It's very important to keep all your ticket, receipts and boarding passes, **because we can pay you, only if you have the tickets).
