Summary

Project „Mess(age) in Media” is an international youth exchange project which involving 6 youngsters from Germany, Italy, Turkey, Greece, Lithuania, Poland and Hungary.

The “Mess(age) in Media” project will be implemented from 3rd-11th of April, 2018 in Veszprém (Hungary). Participants number per country: 5+1. Age limit: between 18-30 (leaders can be 30+). We prefer participants, who will departure from their country.

Arrival day: 3th of April

Departure day: 11th of April

All together there are 7 organizations involved in the project (6 partners + the Lélektér Foundation). Our Foundation also delegates a team and 3 volunteers further to help with the technical issues and administration.

Through the situation of media of nowadays with non-formal education(!) the participants will be supported in their development of becoming conscious consumers, active and moreover conscious citizens of the European Union.

Goals

Short-term goals of the project are to build new international networks, to propagate the Erasmus+ Programme, and to provide development of competencies of the participants' varied skills. The program also aims to generate opportunities to learn and adapt good-practices, to improve language skills of the youngsters.

The long term goal of this project is to increase the knowledge of how to look nowadays' media on a conscious way, recognise the true and the false facts from that, reduce the risk of being a deceived consumer and to support and mobilize young people on their road of becoming conscious citizen of the European Union.

Who can attend?

AGE: Young people aged between 18 and 30 years (leaders can be 30+)

NUMBER OF THE PARTICIPANTS: 5 + 1

Extra cost

Our plan for the travel day is spend a day in our capital, Budapest. Reaching the city and go back to our venue easier, we will rent a private bus which will be available for us for the whole day.

For this we will ask for **10€** from every participant.

Other details

- All reimbursements will be transferred to a participant's personal account or the partner organization's account in ONE AMOUNT
- Transmit the informations and communicate easier, a facebook group will be created for the participants and the group leaders
- Participants are themselves responsible to get their travel insurance
- Unauthorized absence from the activities and the workshops is not permitted. If less than 90% of the activities attended, reimbursement will be cutted or not reimbursed at all

What to bring

- Comfortable clothes for the indoor and outdoor activities (depending on the weather)
- Each group at least one laptop (notebook) to make the working easier
- Traditional foods and drinks for the intercultural nights where each team will introduce their culture, hometown, country etc. If there's any presentations, please prepare with them in advance as well as with the videos.
