## „Sustainable connections”

Training course

### GENERAL INFORMATION ABOUT THE PROJECT:

Main aim of the project „Sustainable connections” is increased awareness about responsible animal care among 45 participants and 3 leaders from Lithuania, Latvia and Poland during 7-days long workshops in Sława. Moreover, we will develop positive relations between people and animals among 48 participants of the project and local community.

During mobility, participants will create educational toys for puppies (made of recycled materials) as well as build up a dialogue and intercultural relations and work for local community.

Workshops will be lead by the Representative of Foundation Dobro.Stan, that deals with: developing close relations between people and animals, education connected with animal welfare and sustainable use of animals with respect for their needs. The Representative of Foundation is a dog behaviourist, who will come to Sława with two dogs to teach youth basic principles of cooperation between human and animal. Trainer will speak about her experience and shall provide practical knowledge about making educational toys made out of fleece- chew toys, the dog lairs and dog sniffing mats. During workshops only recycled materials will be used.

Participants gain ability to create toys, but also will lead discussion about ethical treatment of animals and methods of working with animals. Toys created during workshops will be given to animal shelter. Furthermore, participants alongside with the Representatife of Foundation Dobro.Stan will lead meeting with students/children from one of schools/kindergarten in Sława about animal psychology and prevention of agressive behaviour towards animals.

### PLACE AND DATE:

Mobility for 48 participants – Sława, Lubuskie Voivodeship (Poland), August 23<sup>rd</sup> to 29<sup>th</sup>, 2020 (travel days included).

45 participants and 3 leaders, high school and University students.

Poland, Lithuania and Latvia. 15 participants and 1 leader from each country.

The project will gather 48 participants from three partner organisations (each organisation will send 16 participants).

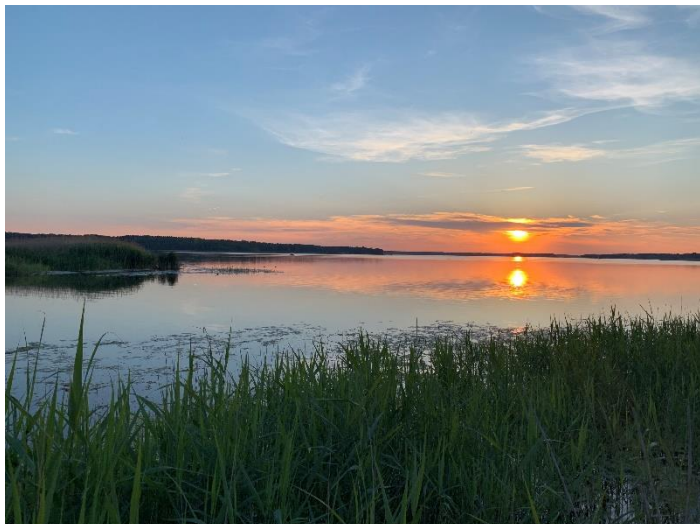

## THE VENUE
