Title: The Mixed Migration

Action: Training Course in Diyarbakir (Turkey)

Project Dates: 5 April (arrival) - 13 April (departure) 2020

Location: Diyarbakir , TURKEY

PROJECT SUMMARY

The Mixed Migration brings issues to light of refugee issues and the social realities they confront, having a Turkish case analysis, for agents of non- governmental organizations in the partnership of the project, taking into consideration a reasonable way to deal with future projects including refugees.

The actual implementation is done through a mobility with partners from 9 European countries (UK, Romania, Lithuania, Slovakia, Bulgaria, Croatia, Poland, Denmark, Czech Republic) and Turkey, between 5th and 13th of April 2020, for 8 days in the districts of Diyarbakir in Turkey.

The Mixed Migration will bring issues to light of refugee issues and the social realities they look in a travel nation for common society delegates inside the project organization, in order to a practical way to deal with future projects including refugees. Clearing up specific perspectives and understanding realities will prompt a subjective increment later on activities of the organizations included and their effect.

The Mixed Migration will accomplish its expressed point by:

1. Building up the capacity of comprehension for 50 youth laborers in 10 nations of the issues looked by refugees and the part of state or private organizations in their administration, giving the case of Turkey.
2. Including 45 youth laborers in 10 nations in the productive exchange of thoughts, experiences and perspectives on refugee issues and the improvement of skills pertinent to working with youths from this class.
3. Making and promoting 3 instruments with important information on the point (1 Study Visit report, 1 photo and video blog, 1 Google

Drive information base) through direct coordinated effort between the all youth organizations included.

4. Expanding worldwide participation inside the system of 10 organizations engaged with the improvement of a communication stage (1 Facebook gathering)



Qualifications of Participants:

For this project, we built a standard participant profile, taking into account the following criteria:

- Age: minimum 18 years old, no upper limit
- Education: Graduates or undergraduates of higher education (bachelor, master, etc)
- Language level: fluency in English
- Youth work background: Presidents, programme directors, project managers in NGOs working with young people; Active leaders of young people from universities, colleges, youth clubs; Young freelancers involved in the NGO environment
- Experience in the field: Experience in working with refugees will be taken into consideration, but we are interested in less experienced participants for whom the Study Visit is a learning opportunity
- Motivation: the purpose of their involvement in the project will have to be well argued and the expectations well defined
- Youth with fewer opportunities (youth unemployment, minorities)

PREPARATION



Presentation: It will be nice to meet your organizations so please make a presentation about the methods that you use to involve young people in activities and show us how.

Cultural Evening: Please arrange with your country participants to bring some gastronomic specialties (food and/or drinks) from your country. It is also strongly recommended to prepare and bring some material showing your country/region/city such as flags and national clothes and of course, your traditional (or modern) music and dances.

Clothes: In April weather can be nice but evenings can be cold. Be ready for both weather.

Energizer: We need all of our participants' fullest energy so bring your energizer ideas to the project!

Insurance: Bring your health and travel insurance papers with you in case.

*****Electronic Devices:** Each group should have their LAPTOPS to be able to work efficiently because the project will be held in an office-like atmosphere.



PRACTICAL INFORMATION

About the city: Diyarbakir is located in central South East of Anatolian region. As Diyarbakir is located near the main roads of Turkey, arrival to the other cities of the county is very easy.

Weather: While the summer season in Diyarbakir is dry and hot, it is snowy and freezing cold (around -10~-5°C) in winter. The weather may also be rainy.

Currency: The official currency in Turkey is Turkish Lira (Turk Lirasi). The prices in Turkey are became little bid expensive last two years but still it is cheaper than many European countries. You can check cost of living in Diyarbakir;

Very important: KEEP ALL THE BILLS, TICKETS AND BOARDING PASSES including electronic ones from your travel, so that we would be able to reimburse the costs. Otherwise, invalid boarding passes and any case of cancellation of the project participation will NOT be considered and reimbursed.

Rooms: There will one, two or max persons in the room. Bed linen will be provided. Please bring your towels. The main activity room is located in the hotel. Wifi internet connection is available. Organisers will provide participants with three meals per day. Food will be served at the hotel's restaurant. We strongly recommend each participant to inform the organizers about any special dietary needs in advance.

HOW TO REACH THE HOTEL

Diyarbakir has an international airport in the city. Mostly you can fly to Diyarbakir through Istanbul, Ankara, Izmir or Antalya Airports. But You can fly to Diyarbakir directly from Dusseldorf or Hannover (Germany), too.

We recommend you to use Momondo.com skyscanner.net skypircker.com in order to find the best offers for travels by plane. We can pick you up from Diyarbakir Airport.

ARRIVAL

When you come to hotel, you will find your name and room at reception desk. There will 2-3 people in one room. You need to bring your private things and towel.

TRAVEL COSTS

According to new Erasmus Plus rules, the reimbursement of travel costs will be calculated using a specific program called Distance Calculator:

AFTER SENDING their tickets and boarding cards, participants will receive the reimbursement of their travel costs. Travel (flights, other means of transport) expenses are compensated (up to 100%), based on the actual expenses incurred and the distance from your location of residence to the location of the project (Diyarbakir). These distances must be calculated using the distance calculator supported by the European Commission. We don't send money to each participants. We send only money to sender organization and sender organization will pay to participants. It may be that money from European Commission will be late; in that case, as mentioned, you will get your reimbursement after the course by bank transfer (be ready for that).

Please note any extra days you wish to stay will be your own responsibility and your food etc.

Visa costs will be covered by participants.

WHAT TO BRING

Since there is going to be an international evening, we will ask you to bring something traditional, famous or delicious from home - that you would like to represent your country with, and share with the others, it can be any kinds of food, drink...

HEALTH INSURANCE

Health insurance is not provided and will not be reimbursed by the organisers. All participants are strongly advised to purchase private travel insurance, as costs of private health care in Turkey are quite high if you don't have.
