

Youth Rhythm for Environment (Youth Exchange)

11-19th July, 2018 Svarstad, Norway



Youth Exchange aims to acknowledge the participants that global solution and global actions should start from our own community in order to prevent an ecological disaster in the near future. Throughout this project young people representing 6 different cultures will meet and interact.

This project will give the opportunity to see how reducing, reusing and recycling is in 6 different countries from the point of view of 55 participants. We will implement our project by using of non-formal educational methods and activities to achieve the following specific objectives:

- To identify and share similarities & differences in practices used in different countries in terms of reducing, reusing and recycling,
- To encourage everyone to participate actively in environmental protection and improvement,
- To increase awareness about reducing, reusing and recycling by shooting videos (they will be created during the project),
- To develop a sense of responsibility and raise youth´ awareness of their own influence on the natural environment,
- To offer the opportunity to meet partner groups and develop concrete ideas for future projects focusing on environmental issues,

- To increase their knowledge on the main theme of the exchange—environment, importance of 3R (reduce, reuse, and recycle),
- To support young people to increase their knowledge about Erasmus + Programme and youth exchange projects in order to develop new projects in the future,
- To create professional videos (we will have experienced participants) and use social media very actively in order to reach as many as people possible for outcomes of our project and for the visibility of Erasmus + Programme.

This exchange will raise the awareness of not only the 3R (reduce-reuse-recycle) but also focus on the protection of the environment, pollution that mankind is making with stuff we produce and consume every day, selection of garbage and garbage removal. 3 professional commercials (3R) will be made during the exchange in order to reach more people for outcomes of our project.

Turkey and Italy will lead 2 different workshops with ‘Recycle’ subject,

Lithuania and Latvia will lead 2 different workshops with ‘Reuse’ subject,

Bulgaria and Norway will lead 2 different workshops with ‘Reduce’ subject.
